Important information about Bussing:

Any students needing the school bus this fall must be registered. It only takes 2 to 3 minutes and is very easy to do. 



WAYS TO STAY SAFE TRAVELING TO AND FROM SCHOOL

Recognize Safe Adults

Teach your children to recognize safe adults such as teachers, staff, and other parents to go to if they need help. Remind them not to accept gifts or go anywhere with someone they do not know

Walk in a Group

Encourage you child to walk or bike to school with friends or in groups. There is safety in numbers. Consider organizing a walking school bus for younger students.

Traffic Safety

Remind your child to follow all traffic rules. Use designated crosswalks, obey traffic signals, and never dash out onto the street. Be alert in parking lots and around vehicles. If your child has their license please remind them to put their cell phones away while driving.

Bullying Prevention

Encourage your child to talk to you or a trusted adult if they feel they are being bullied or witness bullying. Talk to them about the importance of reporting such incidents to school staff as soon as possible when appropriate.

School Board Election Wednesday, November 13, 2024

The school division is divided into ONE (1) CITY SUBDIVISION in which FIVE (5) BOARD MEMBERS are to be elected and FIVE (5) RURAL SUBDIVISIONS in which ONE (1) BOARD MEMBER from each ivision is to be elected

Qualifications of Candidates.... A person is eligible to be nominated as a candidate for and hold office as a BOARD MEMBER for a school division if the person:

- (a) is a voter of the school division on the day of the election;
 (b) is a Canadian citizen at the time he or she submits his or her nomination paper; and
 (c) has resided:
- in the school division for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the date on
- in the study of an easy time consecutive mounts initiation preceding the date on which he or she submitted the nomination paper; and
 in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive mouths immediately preceding the date on which he or she submitted the nomination paper.

A candidate may choose to run in the IN-CITY SUBDIVISION AREA or ONE of the FIVE OUT-OF-CITY AREAS of the school division, regardless of his or her residency in the division; however, he or she must obtain signatures of voters of only that subdivision area in which he or she intends to run.

Nomination Forms....

A person may be nominated as a candidate for election by filing a nomination paper in the prescribed form, signed by ten voters residing in the subdivision in which he or she intends to run.

Filing Nomination Papers.... Nominations will be received by election officials during regular office hours from September 23 until October 8 and on <u>Nomination Day, Wednesday, the 9th day of October, 2024</u> from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. at the following locations:

- Rural Subdivisions at the Education Centre, Saskatchewan Rivers Public School Division No. 119 545 11th Street East, Prince Albert, Saskatchewan S6V 1B1 (regular office hours are 8:00 a.m. until noon and 1:00 p.m. 4:30 p.m.)
- In-City Subdivisions at the City of Prince Albert, 1084 Central Avenue, Prince Albert S6V 7P3 (regular office hours are 8:00 a.m. - 4:45 p.m.)

Nomination paper: may be submitted personally or by agent by personal service, by registered mail, by ordinary mail, by fax, by email or as otherwise specified by the returning officer and must be accompanied by a non-refundable deposit of \$100 or by a certified cheque or money order in that amount made payable to the Saxkatchewan Rivers Public School Division.
